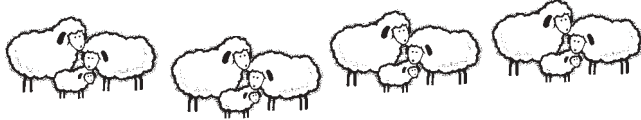

Mission Trip 2010 Barahona, Dominican Republic Church / School Construction Project: The Churches of Jesús Peregrino and La Redención

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This year, I have been blessed with my third opportunity to represent Good Shepherd on a mission trip to the Dominican Republic from July 24–31. I will be leading our team of six for the Vacation Bible School program at Jesús Peregrino while nine other team members will continue the construction work on the mission church La Redención.

The goal for 2010 is to build the walls and close in the roof on the second floor classrooms at La Redención. The Clearwater Deanery team will place the reinforcing steel for the second floor roof. **Vacation Bible School** has been held at Jesús Peregrino each year since 2002 reaching up to 350 children in a session and will once again be offered at Jesús Peregrino.

Who is Involved in This Mission Project?

Each year, a dedicated team of Christian volunteers from the Episcopal Churches in the Clearwater Deanery minister to our sister churches in the Dominican Republic. All Saints Episcopal Church of Hilton Head, South Carolina has also joined us in this effort. The volunteers are of all ages and experiences and have one common goal: to help others help themselves and spread the Good News of our Lord Jesus Christ. They have helped in church construction, provided educational facilities for children, offered Vacation Bible School to the children, and even partnered with local church members to start a small business.

In addition to the construction work and Vacation Bible School program, the mission team members attend church on Sunday and during the week participate in daily worship, prayer, and devotions with our brothers and sisters in the Dominican Republic. This is a beautiful time of sharing the love of Christ with our Dominican Republic neighbors.

What is The Cost?

The estimated cost to complete the five second-story classrooms through the roof level is \$43,650. In addition, we will purchase and collect Vacation Bible School supplies as needed. The cost of the project must be covered through the generosity of Church members like yourself, and friends of the Episcopal Churches in the Clearwater Deanery as well as Hilton Head. All Saints will be contributing \$19,000 and the Dominican Diocese will contribute \$5,000.

The estimated cost of construction and Vacation Bible School material is \$17,000. In addition, it costs approximately \$1,000 per missionary to cover round trip transportation, lodging, and food. Thus, the cost of construction, and Vacation Bible School material as well as transportation, food, and lodging is approximately \$1,500 to \$2,000 per missionary.
